The aromas on the nose carry through beautifully to a charged, fruit driven palate with subtle zing, some flintiness and the lingering taste of guava.

Classic dry white with aromas and flavours of ripe citrus fruits and a lively acidity. Stylish and appetising.

15. **Garnacha 'Fuente Verde', Bodegas Monfil, Cariñena, Spain 2015**

Soft and ripely fruity red with hints of savoury tannins and herbs. Dangerously quaffable and good value for money.
16. **Rosso Terre Siciliane IGT, Tannu, Italy 2014**

The wine has a deep ruby-red colour, with an intense bouquet reminiscent of wild berries, cherries and liquorice. Juicy dark cherry, coffee, chocolate and spice flavours on the palate lead to an intense and persistent finish.

Hand-harvested grapes from old vines provide the raw material for this big and boisterous wine with flavours of red and black fruit with mineral and balsamic notes.
